CHATEAU DE LA FONT DU LOUP BLANC

A largely barrel-fermented blend of 35% each Grenache Blanc and Roussanne with 15% each Bourboulenc and Clairette, the 2018 Châteauneuf-du-Pape Blanc features scents of pencilshavings and grapefruit. It's medium to full-bodied and silky in texture, then folds in notes of citrus rind on the finish.

The 2018 Châteauneuf-du-Pape Blanc offers more sliced apple and pear notes, with some attractive salinity and minerality. Fresh, juicy, and lively on the palate, it's an enjoyable effort that should keep for 2-4 years. This cuvée is a blend of 35% each of Grenache Blanc and Roussanne, with the balance 15% each of Bourboulenc and Clairette, all aged mostly in old barrels, with a small amount in concrete.

The 2017 Châteauneuf-du-Pape Blanc is full-bodied but boasts a seemingly paradoxical set of flavors in a narrow, citrusy band from lime zest to passion fruit. It then turns briny on the finish. Drink it over the next couple of years for its freshness.

The 2017 Châteauneuf-du-Pape Blanc is cut from the same cloth and has classic minerality as well as notes of caramelized apples, brioche, and spice. It's rich yet fresh at the same time, with a medium-bodied, vibrant, balanced style that will keep it drinking nicely for 4-5 years, and I suspect even longer.

Plump and round in the mouth, the 2016 Châteauneuf-du-Pape Blanc is a blend of 35% Grenache Blanc, 35% Roussanne, 15% Bourboulenc and 15% Clairette. It shows a lot of broad fruit flavors, ranging from orange sherbet to pear and guava, ending soft and easy. Drink it young.

A terrific white from the appellation, the 2016 Châteauneuf-du-Pape Blanc is clean and pure, with classy notes of citrus rind, white flowers, lime and crushed rocks. Lean and crisp, yet with substance and length, it's impeccable balanced, has outstanding purity and a great finish. It's going to shine on the dinner table.

The 2015 Châteauneuf-du-Pape Blanc is a fabulous blend of 35% Grenache Blanc, 35% Roussanne, and the rest an even split of Clairette and Bourboulenc. It has a distinct saltiness as well as lots of minerality, white flower and citrus blossom on the nose. These carry over to the palate where the wine is medium-bodied, elegant and supple, with crisp acidity, and plenty of texture and fruit. I'd drink it over the coming couple of years, but I've no doubt it will evolve for longer.
